Empowerment Award Categories

Empowerment Exemplified:

Agency, Organization, Program, Service, Practice

Example: A program or practice which enables older people to stay in their own homes longer and have more say about what kinds of in-home supports they will receive, who will provide them, and when they will receive them.

Example: Something which enables older people to self-manage a chronic condition, so they are not so dependent on the health care system and not so vulnerable to hospitalizations.

Example: An agency which has come up with innovative and effective ways for older people to be active participants in designing the agency's programs, evaluating the quality and effectiveness of its programs, etc.

Empowerment Exemplified:

Individual Leadership

Example: A person who has been a strong voice on the issue of the empowerment of older adults within their organization or on a broader scale; or who has pioneered practices which have clearly increased aging empowerment.
